

TROOP 370 DISCIPLINE:

We expect the Scouts too at least partially, police their own ranks and decide on discipline. There will be no hazing or "hands on". The "3 Strike Rule" is the basis for troop discipline.

- 1st Strike - Verbal warning
- 2nd Strike - The Scouts name written down
- 3rd Strike - Parents are called to come pick up their son

We expect this to rarely happen and only occur in extreme circumstances. Some examples of behavior that warrants a "Strike".

- Foul or abusive language
- Striking another Scout
- Disrespect toward adults
- Stealing

Some actions are severe enough to warrant immediate dismissal from a troop activity. Among them are:

- Threatening with a knife or other weapon
- Causing severe bodily harm to self or others
- Caught with alcohol or tobacco
- Uncontrolled behavior
- Sexual misconduct

After upon leadership review of severe occurrences, a Scout may be asked to refrain from troop activities for a specified period or, in the most severe cases, dismissed from the troop all together. Again, we expect this will happen rarely and these actions only taken in the most extreme cases.
